Directions to Hike (Round Trip Distance 0 Miles):

From I-270 on southwest side of town, take the West Broad Street (U.S. 40) exit west. Go about 5 miles and turn left/south on Darby Creek Drive. Continue about 3 miles to the main entrance on the right. Park in the Cedar Ridge picnic area, near the Ranger Station. DO NOT park at the Nature center where the bison are. Restrooms are here by Ranger Station.

Hike Description:

These creeks are renowned for water quality. We will hike a variety of the trails, including along Big Darby Creek. The trails are gravel and grass with a few hills to climb.

Suggested Items text Bring:

Water, Hiking/walking shoes, hiking stick, and dress for the weather.
