### **Directions to Hike (Round Trip Distance 000 Miles):**

9466 Columbus Pike, Lewis Center OH 43035.

From I-270, take US 23 north about 3 miles. Entrance is on the left, just before Powell Road. We will meet in the Nature Center. (First building on right after you enter Park.) Restrooms here.

### **Hike Description:**

Walk through hardwood forests and shale ravines to a 110-foot elevation view of the Olentangy River. Pass a cemetery of the first area settlers. Stop by a burial mound left by the ancient Adena Indians. You will see why this park has been designated a National Natural Landmark. Some moderate hills.

### **Suggested Items to Bring:**

Water, hiking boots and sticks. Dress for the weather.

### **Dinner Location and Directions:**

Ruby Tuesday, 8753 Owenfield Dr., Powell, OH 43065 (740-548-1670)

Exit Park and turn left/north on US-23/Columbus Pike. Pass the intersection with Powell Rd. At the next traffic light (Meadow Park Ave) turn left and then right onto Owenfield Dr. Pass White Castle on right. Note mailbox with #8753 at curb. Turn right into parking area.
